WALKING INTO THE FUTURE


It may not be easy for all of us to believe that we will have forward momentum as a congregation anytime soon. With the pandemic once again intensifying, our political climate dangerously stormy, and loss upon loss (loneliness, sickness, even death) afflicting our church family, it's hard to envision a bright future, much less summon a lot of enthusiasm for taking steps in that direction.

And yet, in just a couple of weeks, we'll be holding our Annual Congregational Meeting (see article on p. 2) and looking toward this new year and beyond. We'll be looking at the financial resources God's blessed us with and the people he's calling to serve in leadership roles. And we'll consider the Growing Season proposal as a possible roadmap for the near-term future.

For some of us, this process will appeal to our optimistic, forward-looking nature. Others of us will likely find some skepticism creeping into our thoughts. But, while none of us can predict the specifics of the future ahead of us, we do know one thing: we don't go alone. God is always there in the future with unknown blessings. And we have each other—a congregation of people gathered by the Holy Spirit and bound to one another by faith and friendships.

Last Sunday morning, Shelley Colwell shared this passage of Scripture with us at the start of our online communion service: "Those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint" (Isaiah 40:31). What an encouraging message! God gives new strength when we need it most. And, even if we don't soar, even if we can't run, we can still put one foot in front of the other and keep moving forward...together.

A VERY DIFFERENT ANNUAL MEETING

Because of COVID, New Spirit's 2020 Annual Congregational meeting is going to be different in a number of ways. One way is obvious: We've postponed the meeting from December to January. But now we also have to carry out our Annual Meeting without being together in person.



The Grand Canyon Synod held an online session with lawyers who had researched the law for this kind of meeting in the three states where the synod has churches. Based on the advice for Arizona congregations, our meeting will have two parts. Here's a summary followed by a more detailed explanation.

Quick Summary

Based on legal advice shared by the Grand Canyon Synod with Arizona congregations, our 2020 Annual Meeting will have two components:

- (1) On Sunday, January 31, at 10:00, we will have an online meeting via Zoom that will begin with a brief communion service and be followed by the agenda we would ordinarily cover at an annual meeting. However, this will *not* be the official meeting. It will be considered an informational meeting. It will include: discussion of things that are up for vote, opening the floor for nominations, discussion of proposed amendments, etc., but it will *not* include voting.
- (2) The official Annual Meeting will consist of the marking and mailing in of ballots. You will receive an addressed and stamped envelope along with your ballots (see below). After the January 31 informational meeting has happened, you will mail in your marked ballots.

Note: This seems as strange to us as it probably does to you, but we're in a strange time, and this is what the legal experts say is the best way to proceed.

Detailed Explanation

Here is a step-by-step explanation of how this will work:

First, a note on who is a voting member of New Spirit. To be a voting member, you need to (a) be a member of New Spirit, who (b) has communed at New Spirit in the current or previous calendar year, and who (c) has made a financial contribution of record in the current or previous calendar year. Because this will officially be the 2020 Annual Meeting (postponed into 2021 because of circumstances), the calendar years in question are 2019-2020. If you are unsure of your status, please contact Nancy in the office at 520-296-2461 or nancy@newspiritlutherantucson.org.

Approximately ten days before the January 31 online informational meeting, we will mail out a packet to every voting member. The packet will include, among other things, the proposed budget, information on nominees for leadership roles, ballots, and a stamped and addressed envelope for mailing ballots to church.

When you receive your packet, please read through the materials ahead of the meeting and raise any questions you have with a council member or pastor. This will help us know what needs correction or further explanation when we gather. This is especially important for anyone who is unable to get online. We want to strongly encourage those folks to get in touch with a council member or one of the pastors with any thoughts or questions.

On January 31, we'll meet online (see Zoom link below) and proceed as we would with any congregational meeting, with the exception that we won't cast votes. Amendments to the budget or the Growing Season proposal will be considered but will have to be decided by a voice vote or show of hands. Nominations from the floor will be received. (Please note: If you intend to nominate someone for a position, be sure to check beforehand to make sure that person is willing to serve.)

On Monday, February 1, we will let everyone know by email (or by phone for those who don't use email) whether there were any additional nominations and/or changes to the budget and/or the Growing Season proposal.

If there are changes, you'll get instructions on how to proceed with voting.

If there are no changes, you can go ahead and vote with the ballots as you received them.

Mail your ballots using the SASE enclosed in your packet. We will count votes as they are received, completing the count on Thursday, February 11.

Again, we realize that this is a far-less-than-optimal approach to what should be a wonderful chance to gather, review what's gone before, and look to the future *together*. God willing, we will be back to that next year. In the meantime, we ask for your patience and that you would put the best construction on the work and the decisions of your elected leaders and your pastors as we do our best to help the congregation adapt to current pandemic circumstances.

TAX SITE INFORMATION

Although the tax site will not open this year to the general public, Terry Mysak, Carol, and I are going to be doing taxes for friends and family, **starting in February**. This includes members of New Spirit. As always, this is a free service. Here's what the taxpayer needs to do to get their taxes done:

1. Call me, John (850-5999) or Terry (784-1341) to make an appointment. **Do not call the church office.**

- 2. There will be a box set up outside of the church office door for these steps. Stop by the church and pick up a form (intake sheet) to take home and fill out.
- 3. Return the intake sheet along with all tax docs, including a copy of last years (2019) tax return, to the church office. Call one of us to let us know it's there. One of us will pick it up.
- 4. If you want your refund directly deposited or your payment taken out of your checking include a voided check with the documents.
- 5. Be sure you have a valid phone number on the intake sheet. It would be helpful to include an email address if you have one.
- 6. We will call you when we are done with your return and let you know the results. We will meet you at the church to sign for it.

Please be patient. Remember we are volunteers and there are only three of us doing returns. As always your return will be double-checked before it is e-filed.
